### **OPELIKA DRIVER LICENSE EXAMINING OFFICE TO RELOCATE MAY 2** *Office Slated to Close for Two Days during Move*


Effective Tuesday, May 2, the Opelika Driver License Examining Office will open for business at its new location: 1220 Foxrun Parkway. Located near the Opelika State Trooper Post, the new office offers more space to better accommodate increasing demands for driver license services in the area.

“The new, more spacious office will enhance the efficiency of driver license operations, and will offer room for future expansion in this rapidly growing area of the state,” said Public Safety Director Col. W.M. Coppage.

The last business day at the old location, 611 South Railroad Ave., is Thursday, April 27. That office will be closed for two days during the move: Friday, April 28, and Monday, May 1.

All services – including driver license testing, reinstatement, and copies of wreck reports and driver records – will be unavailable during the two-day office closing April 28 and May 1. Renewals at the probate judge’s office will, however, be unaffected by the two-day closing.
