New DL Office to Open at Redstone Arsenal on Wednesday


An additional driver license office will open Wednesday, July 18, at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville. Located on Acton Road in Building 3220, the office will be open one day each week, on Wednesdays only, from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The office will close from 12 noon to 12:30 p.m. for lunch.

Public Safety Director Col. Christopher Murphy said the new Redstone Arsenal office offers a convenient alternative for driver license applicants who have access to the arsenal. He said having a second license office in the busy Huntsville district will improve customer service, reduce wait times, and help meet the increasing demand for driver license services in that area.

The office will offer a variety of driver license services, but will not conduct road skills testing. Services include processing transfer of out-of-state licenses, issuance of license renewals and identification cards, and knowledge testing for class D, motorcycle and vessel licenses and endorsements.

In accordance with Governor Riley's pledge to address problems in the licensing system, Murphy said the Department of Public Safety would continue efforts to improve services at driver license offices statewide.
