Area Driver License Examining Offices to Change Days of Service

Effective Monday, March 5, several area Driver License examining offices will modify hours of operation.

The Franklin County office, which is in Russellville, currently is open 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday. Its hours of operation will change to 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday. The office is at the Franklin County Courthouse, 410 N. Jackson Ave., Russellville; 256-332-8888.

The Lamar County office, which is in Vernon, currently is open 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Monday and Tuesday. Its hours of operation will be reduced from two days to one day per week, 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Thursday. The office is at the Lamar County Jail, 1118 County Road 9, Vernon; 205-695-7105.

The Winston County office, which is in Double Springs, currently is open 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Wednesday and Thursday. Its hours of operation also will be reduced from two days to one day per week, 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. Wednesday. The office is at Double Springs Municipal Building, 23415 Highway 195, Double Springs; 205-489-1141.
