ABI: U.S. Marshals Offer Reward in Triple Murder Investigation

The Alabama Bureau of Investigation, a division of the Alabama Department of Public Safety, announces that the U.S. Marshals Service has authorized a \$5,000 reward for information leading to the arrest of Deandra Marquis Lee, who is sought in connection with a triple homicide in Lowndes County.

On Thursday, June 7, 2012, warrants for Lee were obtained, charging him in the murder of 9-year-old twins Jordan and Taylor Dejerinett and their caregiver, Jack Mac Girdner, 73. The bodies of the Dejerinett twins and Girdner were discovered along a remote Lowndes County road late Tuesday afternoon.
