PUBLIC SAFETY UPDATES INVESTIGATION INFORMATION


MONTGOMERY — There have been developments late this afternoon in the continuing investigation into the multiple homicides in south Alabama.

The Alabama Bureau of Investigation has in its possession all evidence collected from the scene of the first event, which is the house of Lisa White McLendon, Michael Kenneth McLendon's mother, which is located on Coffee County Road 474 in Kinston. The evidence includes a phone list and a notebook, but there is no evidence that indicates a hit list of any kind.

Second, there have been very recent developments that we believe may direct us to a motive. We believe that this horrific situation began and ended with this series of events yesterday, perpetrated by this single individual, that there is no evidence of further complicity. Colonel Murphy earlier referred to second-tier investigations, and we are beginning to see those results. We are still examining and pursuing this new information as the investigation progresses, and it would be premature at this time to comment further in any detail.

We will get additional developments to you as soon as the investigation allows.
