

History:

The number of incidents in the recent past of metal coils dropping, falling, shifting or otherwise escaping from commercial vehicles warrants the emergency adoption of this law that sets forth the method by which a commercial vehicle operator can become certified in proper metal coil load securement.

This new law will apply to all carriers and drivers, both intrastate and interstate for the transportation of any metal coils on any highway, road or interstate inside Alabama when the load has an origination or destination in Alabama.

To become certified in proper metal coil load securement as required by Code of Alabama 1975, §32-9A-2(a)(4)a., a commercial vehicle driver must:

- Complete the Securing Metal Coils Course that can be accessed through the website www.metalcoiltraining.com and pay the 15.00 exam fee and take the exam that is part of the course;
- Obtain a copy of the certificate that notes successful completion of the course and that is generated by the testing website upon passage of the exam;
- Sign the certificate and also have an official from the motor carrier for which he/she hauls or will haul metal coils sign the certificate;
- Retain the original copy of the fully-signed certificate in the commercial vehicle when hauling metal coils; and
- Provide each and every motor carrier for which he/she hauls or will haul metal coils with a fully-signed copy of the certificate.

The certificates may be laminated and replacement copies may be obtained through the website where you took the exam.

Certification is only available via the internet through this website.
