DPS Expands Program to Schedule Road Skills Tests to Dothan

MONTGOMERY – Department of Public Safety Director Col. J. Christopher Murphy announced DPS will expand its appointments scheduling program to the Dothan Driver License Examining Office effective July 1.

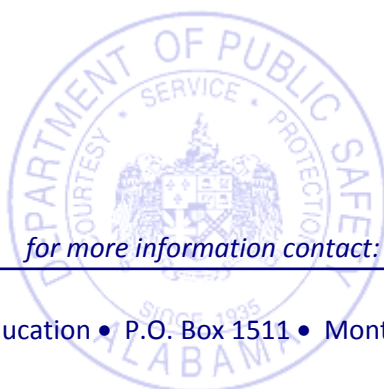
Applicants for the road skills test may schedule an appointment via e-mail through Public Safety's Web site, <http://dps.alabama.gov>, or they may call (334) 983-5616 during regular business hours. Located at 5679 Montgomery Highway, the office also will continue to accept walk-in applicants on a first-come, first-served basis.

Appointments are available at examining offices in Birmingham, Huntsville, Mobile, Montgomery, Opelika and Tuscaloosa. The scheduling service was launched in 2007, and has proved a convenient option for many driver license customers.

Murphy said this latest change reflects Public Safety's ongoing commitment to customer service in all areas of driver licensing. He cited the support and leadership of Gov. Bob Riley and the Alabama legislature as key to improvements that have been achieved.

"Gov. Riley and Alabama's legislators have made improving driver license services a priority, and we are grateful for their support of our work to better serve Alabamians," said Murphy.
